



## CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING WINE

- 1 **MERCIER BRUT**  
*Flute (125ml) £9.50    Bottle £55*  
An assemblage of Pinot Noir Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay varieties - Brut Mercier has a straw yellow colouring. Its nose is dominated by seeded white fruits which blend with notes of freshly baked bread. The high proportion of Pinot grapes is expressed in a palate of ripe apple and pear aromas which climax in a delightfully fresh finish.
  - 2 **MOËT & CHANDON IMPERIAL**  
*Flute (125ml) £11    Bottle £65*  
Flowery and fresh with notes of brioche and citrus, together with a clean persistent mousse.
  - 3 **VEUVE CLICQUOT**  
*Flute (125ml) £10    Bottle £75*  
A famous Champagne for all the right reasons – a richer more flavoursome fizz with layers of baked apple fruit and a nice touch of cream on the finish.
  - 4 **MOËT & CHANDON ICE**  
*Flute (125ml) £11    Bottle £75*  
Ice Impérial, the first and only champagne especially created to be enjoyed over ice. A new champagne experience combining fun, fresh and free sensations while remaining true to the Moët & Chandon style, a style distinguished by its bright fruitiness, its seductive palate and its elegant maturity.
  - 5 **RUINART**  
*Flute (125ml) £12    Bottle £80*  
Elegant and well-structured with a fine persistent mousse. Citrus fruit and nutty notes with hints of cream and a long dry finish. Ruinart is the earliest-established Champagne house.
  - 6 **MOËT & CHANDON ROSE**  
*Flute (125ml) £13.50    Bottle £80*  
Lively and expressive dominated by the scent of wild strawberries. Full-bodied and zesty.
  - 7 **MOËT & CHANDON GRAND VINTAGE**  
*£99*  
Bright, pale yellow with glints of green, and fine, persistent bubbles. Initial notes of fresh white flowers evolve towards sweet, fragrant pastries, with occasional scents of fresh walnuts, hazelnuts and biscuits. The fruit is crisp, freshly ripened, with aromas of pear, white peach and nectarine.
  - 8 **RUINART ROSE**  
*£99*  
A fine-beaded Champagne with distinctive redcurrant aromas, leading to a fresh fruity palate, with well-balanced acidity.
  - 9 **RUINART BLANC DE BLANC**  
*£99*  
Made from 100% chardonnay grapes, which produces a refined delicate Champagne with floral notes and a lingering creamy finish.
  - 10 **DOM PERIGNON**  
*£185*  
The delicate aromas and flavours of Dom Perignon really develop in the glass when savoured slowly, as floral zesty notes give way to complex hazelnut brioche and cream.
  - 11 **KRUG**  
*£210*  
A magnificent full-bodied Champagne fermented in oak barrels and blended from up to twenty different vintages for a decadently rich style. Enjoy!
  - 12 **KRUG VINTAGE**  
*£299*  
A truly elegant and very intense vintage Krug. This is a rich sumptuous and absolutely gorgeous vintage Champagne. It has a pale golden colour seductive white flower aromas and a full creamy and rich palate with flavours of grapefruit biscuit and hints of tropical fruits.
  - 13 **FRESCHELLO ROSE**  
*£33*  
Bright pink coral colour. Candied aromas and flavours of strawberry with a vibrant, effervescent, fruity light-to-medium body and a graceful, breezy finish. Accents of red licorice, anise, and peach sauce with soft, fruit tannins and no oak. A tasty and effortlessly drinkable sparkling rose for any occasion.
  - 14 **VINETO DI FURI**  
*Flute (125ml) £7    Bottle £33*  
Fully sparkling lightly nutty and fruity. Clean and fresh on the palate.
- CREMANT CH LANGLOIS BRUT**  
*£46*  
Light yellow colour with fine, delicate bubbles. A complex nose mixing different fruits such as quince, peach and grapefruit lead to a fresh finish with a delicate and refined mouth-feel.



## DIRECTORS WHITE

- D1 WILD ROCK INFAMOUS GOOSE SAUVIGNON BLANC**  
*New Zealand. £43.50*  
Another excellent sauvignon from Marlborough: a lovely bouquet of fresh gooseberries and cut grass, leads to a crisp palate with a long minerally dry finish.
- D2 PETIT CHABLIS ALAIN GEOFFROY**  
*France. £45*  
Crisp dry white Burgundy with notes of fig and lime, underpinned by mineral acidity.
- D3 MACON LUGNY PETITES PIERRES**  
*France. £52*  
This white wine is made by Louis Jadot in Burgundy, with elegant fruit-driven flavours. Formed from primarily Chardonnay grapes, this wine is ethically produced, vegan and vegetarian friendly. Lying in the northern part of the Côte Mâconnaise, this well-known village produces wines which are noted for a delightful floral, fruity aroma and fresh lemony palate which epitomises the best of this sometimes underrated region of Burgundy.
- D4 SANCERRE LANGLOIS CHATEAU**  
*France. £55*  
100% Sauvignon Blanc from Langlois-Chateau's best vineyards in the Sancerre AOC. This serious and complex Sancerre is a benchmark for the appellation, with brightness, intensity, depth and minerality.
- D5 POUILLY FUISSE**  
*France. £55*  
This stunning unoaked wine is produced from a tiny plot of over 50 year old vines ~ superb clean fruit and a full rich palate.
- D6 LYME BAY CHARDONNAY**  
*England. £60*  
A well-rounded pale gold dry wine, with subtle buttery flavours and aromas of peach turnover and honey.
- D7 MEERLUST CHARDONNAY**  
*South Africa. £60*  
Only a tiny amount of this iconic Chardonnay is made each year ~ combines delicacy and depth. Ripe melon with rich, smoky, toasty depth.
- D8 DROUHIN SAINT VERAN - BURGUNDY**  
*France. £65*  
A wine that smiles and makes you smile! The palate shows subtle aromas of peaches and pear with hints of fresh almonds and honey. It is stylistically close to Pouilly-Fuissé, with its golden hue, its greenish reflection and its refreshing taste. The aromas are reminiscent of the ripe Chardonnay grape, with subtle notes of musk. A pleasant roundness coats the palate.
- D9 SANTENAY LE ROCHE**  
*France. £65*  
White Santenay from vineyards neighbouring those of Chassagne Montrachet. The wine receives 12 months barrel ageing which adds additional complexity to the rich fruit flavours. Deliciously forward and welcoming palate with good length.
- D10 BOUCHARD PULIGNY MONTRACHET**  
*France. £95*  
Delicious floral and fruit aromas with notes of oak on the nose. An attractive marriage between power and elegance. Beautifully smooth.

## DIRECTORS RED

- D12 CHATEAU PUY BLANQUET**  
*France. £60*  
A deep red coloured wine with abundant red fruit aromas and flavours. Great body from the Merlot with supple, silky tannins on the finish.
- D13 2014 CH PUY BLANQUET GR CRU ST EMILION**  
*France. £60*  
Inky ripe Merlot fruit drinking very well – showing ripe damson and plum, with notes of mint cedar and dark chocolate and a velvety finish.
- D14 ARONUI SINGLE VINEYARD PINOT NOIR**  
*New Zealand. £60*  
A vibrant ruby red hue in the glass, this a full bodied and complex Pinot Noir from Nelson - displaying rich dark fruits and smoky, spicy French oak on the nose. Powerfully concentrated on the palate with ripe plum, subtle earthy notes and balanced smooth tannins, this wine is both expressive and persistent - leading to a long and lingering finish.
- D15 PAINTED WOLF PICTUS IV**  
*South Africa. £65*  
An elegant, medium full-bodied wine combining charm with power, red berry and spice and a long, polished finish.
- D16 BY MEDOC BORDEAUX**  
*France. £65*  
A wonderfully ripe Médoc characterised by sappy blackcurrant fruit with an attractive earthy edge.
- D17 CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE JULIETTE AVRIL**  
*France. £75*  
This popular Rhone wine is made predominantly from grenache grapes, giving intense robust spicy flavours and a long peppery finish.
- D18 BOTTER AMARONE DELLA VALPOLICELLA**  
*Italy. £80*  
This wine has been carefully produced from grapes which have been laid out to dry and become concentrated. The result is rich concentrated full-bodied with a long finish.
- D20 CHATEAU PICHON**  
*France. £125*  
Fifty percent Merlot, 32% Cabernet Sauvignon and the rest Cabernet Franc with a touch of Petit Verdot has resulted in a chocolatey, ripe, round, elegant style of wine with medium body, sweet tannins, and a good finish.
- D21 CHATEAU PICHON LONGUEVILLE LALANDE**  
*France. £280*  
Distinctive bouquet of violets, soy, pepper, blackberries, cassis, and tree bark ~ exhibits plenty of structure, wonderful sweetness and a rich, textured, persistent character.
- D22 PENFOLDS GRANGE 1995**  
*Australia. £575*  
Displaying all the classic hallmarks one would expect of Grange, this is a full-bodied, richly flavoured wine with ripe, dark stewed fruits and mixed spices with seamless, perfectly integrated oak and chewy tannins.



## WHITE WINES

- 15 **MATRA HILL PINOT GRIGIO**  
*Hungary. 175ml £6.25 250ml £8.25 Bottle £25*  
A crisp dry white, light and refreshing with hints of green fruits and pears.
- 16 **COORONG ESTATE CHARDONNAY**  
*Australia. 175ml £6.25 250ml £8.25 Bottle £25*  
A delicious juicy, fresh and fruity Chardonnay from 'Down Under' - clean melon and peach characters with a hint of cream.
- 17 **SOUTHERN LIGHTS SAUVIGNON BLANC**  
*New Zealand. 175ml £7 250ml £9.75 Bottle £30*  
A fresh and vibrant wine with passionfruit, gooseberries and some melon characters.
- 18 **PICPOUL DE PINET ORMARINE**  
*France. 175ml £6.75 250ml £9.75 Bottle £29*  
Dry light and fruity, with lively acidity. Aromas of lemon, green apples and spring blossom.
- 19 **ALBAPIANA VIOGNIER**  
*Italy. 175ml £6.75 250ml £9.75 Bottle £29*  
Pale straw yellow with green highlights. A bouquet of peaches, floral notes of Roses, Green apple, Apricot and light hints of walnuts and Honeysuckle. The palate offers a light to medium-bodied, fresh and clean texture combined with flavours of dried apricot, well-balanced acidity, and long persistent finish.
- 20 **PAINTED WOLF CHENIN BLANC**  
*South Africa. 175ml £7 250ml £9.75 Bottle £30*  
This wine has a bright aroma and flavour of tropical fruit: honeydew melon, guava and pineapple with an underlying savoury minerality. A great texture, and a long, layered finish with bright acidity keeping it fresh and vibrant.
- 21 **FORTIUS BARREL AGED CHARDONNAY**  
*Spain. 175ml £7.50 250ml £9.50 Bottle £33*  
Clean, bright, elegant, intense gold color. Intense and complex. Marked by toasted barrel notes, such as toasted hazelnuts. Ripe fruits hints background (like pear). Smooth, homogeneous and good acidity. Full-bodied and covering. Very balanced between wood and frutal notes.
- 21A **GRANDE ARDECHE CHARDONNAY LATOUR**  
*France. £41*  
From one of Burgundy's most consistent estates comes this elegant chardonnay perfectly balanced between ripe stone fruits and subtle oak.
- 22 **WARWICK ESTATE, FIRST LADY CHARDONNAY**  
*South Africa. £33*  
Light straw colour with flecks of green. This wine is drenched in citrus lemon, lime and orange peel- with a healthy dose of apple blossom fragrance. On the palate pineapple, apple and lemony freshness is underscored by a subtle wet stone salinity. A gently textured mouthful draws into a bright yet lingering acidity.
- 23 **THE CROSSINGS SAUVIGNON BLANC**  
*New Zealand. £37*  
The Crossings' flagship varietal, this Sauvignon Blanc is made from a blend of selected parcels from the three vineyards. The wine presents powerful aromas of passionfruit on the nose combined with a complex palate where melon and stone fruit flavours are underpinned by a racy acidity, and the classic flinty mineral undertones of Awatere sauvignon blanc.
- 24 **VOUVRAY COMTE DE LA BOISSERIE**  
*France. £37*  
Light fresh and flowery with a hint of honey. Just off dry, this is soft flowery and gentle.
- 25 **FAMILLE VALERY PAS D'HISTOIRES LE BLANC**  
*France. £40*  
Pas d'Histoires translates as "no fuss", which is what they are aiming for when blending this wine - easygoing and very drinkable. This is a traditional southern French white blend of Marsanne (50%), Roussanne (30%), Grenache Blanc (10%) & Viognier (10%) from the Valéry family farm between Béziers and the Mediterranean sea. Plush and fruit-forward, finishes fresh.
- 26 **DR LOOSEN RED SLATE RIESLING**  
*Germany. £40*  
Red Slate Riesling Dry is produced with fruit from estate-owned vineyards in the red slate soils in the villages of Erden and Ürzig. There is an intense minerality that is warm and enveloping, with a floral, spicy, citrus blossom aroma and a harmonious palate. The dry style is ideal for classic continental cuisine.
- 27 **PFUFF PINOT GRIS ALSACE**  
*France. £40*  
Well-balanced and expressive with the spice that is typical of this grape. Fresh and persistent with notes of honey, pineapple, lychee and a hint of rose.

## ROSÉ WINES

- 28 **MATRA HILL PINOT GRIGIO BLUSH ROSÉ**  
*Hungary. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.75 Bottle £26*  
This blush is made from Pinot Grigio grapes which turn to a light copper colour as they ripen towards the end of the growing season. A fruity rosé with notes of citrus and cherry.
- 29 **WILDWOOD ZINFANDEL**  
*USA. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.75 Bottle £26*  
Mouth-watering summer berry flavours create this refreshing rosé. Juicy ripe strawberries and sweet candy are incredibly scrumptuous and ever so moreish.
- 30 **LA LAGUNA ROSÉ**  
*Spain. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.75 Bottle £26*  
Pale pink in colour with floral aromas of roses and wildflowers. With an elegant floral palate, supplemented with a balanced acidity and structure, this wine offers a fresh finish with a slight mineral note.
- 31 **DOMAINE DE LA BAUME PINOT NOIR ROSÉ**  
*France. £37.50*  
An excellent clean and fruity rosé from the South of France, with a refreshingly medium dry finish. Intense vine, peach, and citrus aromas with a palate full of freshness which is perfectly balanced.
- 32 **M DE MINUTY PROVENCE ROSÉ**  
*France. £47*  
Very pale in colour with silvery glints. Subtle to the nose with little white fruits and tangerine notes. Amazing roundness well-balanced by a good freshness supported by citrus zest notes.
- 33 **MIGUEL TORRES SANTA DIGNA CABERNET SAUVIGNON ROSÉ**  
*Chile. £26*  
100% Cabernet Sauvignon, this beautifully balanced rosé has an aroma of red berries and spice with a fresh rounded palate.
- 33A **FEDELE ROSE ORGANIC**  
*Italy. £27*  
A highly characterful, bright rose, with tons of fresh red berry fruit flavours - lively and vibrant.



## RED WINES

- 34 **COORONG ESTATE SHIRAZ**  
*Australia. 175ml £7.25 250ml £9.25 Bottle £27.50*  
A rich and spicy Shiraz with wonderful flavours of black fruits, black pepper and sweet spices. This is an easy-drinking wine with soft tannins and a warm finish. Sweet earthiness and lifted florals, blueberries, tobacco and spice in the bouquet
- 35 **CA DEL LAGO CABERNET SAUVIGNON**  
*Italy. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.75 Bottle £26*  
Aromas of red berries dried cranberries and apricots. An elegant and succulent wine with great integrated tannins. A hint of vanilla and truffle notes.
- 36 **PEQUEN MERLOT**  
*Chile. 175ml £6.25 250ml £8.25 Bottle £25*  
A vibrant ruby red wine with violet hues. This Merlot is concentrated with rich aromas of plums and cherries, and hints of cinnamon, tobacco and vanilla on the palate.
- 37 **TREWA CARMENERE**  
*Chile. 175ml £6.25 250ml £8.25 Bottle £25*  
Trewa Carmenere is a brilliant red ruby colour. Aromas of plums, blackberries and cassis with sweet spicy touches. Flavours of black fruits and vanilla. Its tannins are silky and juicy.
- 38 **ALTO DE MAYO MALBEC**  
*Argentina. 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.50 Bottle £25*  
Wonderfully rich plum, cherry and blackcurrant flavours that lead to a smooth finish.
- 39 **SANTIAGO CRIANZA RIOJA**  
*Spain. 175ml £7 250ml £9.50 Bottle £29*  
Lovely raspberry, damson and sloe fruit flavours, with streaks of fine toasty vanilla and ripe tannins.
- 40 **PAINTED WOLF PINOTAGE**  
*South Africa. 175ml £7.50 250ml £10 Bottle £30*  
Medium to full bodied with bright red and black summer berries, savoury spice, and toasty wood flavours - leading to a nicely poised finish.
- 41 **NEROPASSO ROSSO IGT**  
*Italy. £32*  
After meticulous work in the vineyard to ensure even ripening, whole bunches are harvested by hand undergoing strict selection to allow a steady drying process before crushing and fermentation. The juice of the dried grapes gives the wine so much concentration and complexity. Spicy, velvet textured wine, with indulgent dried fruit and smooth tannin.
- 42 **U'PASSIMENTO**  
*Italy. £32*  
Made from partially dried grapes, this wine has bright intense red fruit on the nose displaying lots of red berries. The palate is warm and full-bodied with sweet fruit, harmonious acidity, and smooth and elegant tannins.
- 43 **DOMAINE MAS BELLES PETIT VERDOT**  
*France. £30*  
This has a wonderfully aromatic nose with notes of violet, kirsch and vanilla. The palate is firm and rounded with excellent length of flavour and terrific balance. You get blackcurrant, cherry, and some cedar notes on the long and flavoursome finish.
- 44 **ROTHSCHILD PINOT NOIR**  
*Languedoc. £33*  
Sour cherry, strawberry and raspberry mingled with a delicate note of spice. The palate is light and fresh, although it has impressive balance and plenty of red fruit. This Pinot is uncomplicated, but excellent value and easy drinking
- 45 **VIGNETI RADICA MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO DOC**  
*Italy. £34*  
Red fruit with spicy notes of chocolate and vanilla. Well-bodied, supple, balanced and persistent taste.
- 46 **SEPTIMA MALBEC**  
*France. £35*  
Aromas of fresh berries balanced with the oak, plus vanilla and roasted scents with a velvety full-bodied palate
- 47 **SEGUALA COTE DE ROUSSILON VILLAGES**  
*France. £43*  
Plump, well-rounded and with an abundance of damson and plum fruit, from a small producer making stunning value wines.
- 48 **COTES DU RHONE GUIGAL**  
*France. £45*  
From one of the Rhone valley's most prestigious producers, this red is medium-bodied with soft cherry and raspberry fruit, and a warming peppery finish.
- 49 **PAINTED WOLF PINOTAGE GUILLERMO**  
*South Africa. £45*  
An intense, rich wine packed with flavours of ripe blueberry and mulberry, exotic spice and creamy vanilla with evident ripe tannins and a long lingering finish.
- 50 **BLACKBIRD SANGIOVESE**  
*Clare Valley, Australia. £50*  
The 'Blackbird' is all about artisan, small batch winemaking. A wonderfully full flavoured and balanced, medium-weight bright ruby red wine. Elegant, velvety tannins fill the mouth. The aromatics are lifted and appealing; fresh cranberries with green olives and lots of Sangiovese light berry fruits.
- 50A **PORTIA ROBLE RIBERA DEL DUERO**  
*Spain. £42*  
Clean, bright, well covered, cherry, purple flashes. Nose: intense, dark fruit, blackberry and wood. Mouth: good structure, round tannins, good acidity and a good wood finish.
